Durham Station/ DPAC	From the stop at Fayetteville St take DATA 5 Inbound, DPAC is the next to last stop	American Tobacco Campus, Durham Bulls Athletic Park
RDU Airport	From East Lawson St at Rosewood, take the Triangle Transit 700 to the Regional Transit Center then take the Triangle Transit 100 to Terminal 1 or 2	
NCSU	From East Lawson St take the Traingle Transit 700 to the Regional Transit Center, then take the Triangle Transit 100 or 105 to Hillsborough St	Bruegger's Bagels, Cup a Joe, DH Hill Library, Chile Bomba, Mitch's Tavern, School Kids Records, East Village
UNC	From East Lawson St take the DATA 5 to Durham Station, then take the Triangle Transit 400 or 405 to Franklin St.	Ben & Jerry's Carolina Coffee House, Jack Spratt, Qdoba, Starbucks, Top of the Hill, Varsity Theater
Southpoint Mall	From Fayetteville St at Brant, take DATA 5 Outbound	Apple Store, AE, Belks, Nordstrom, Urban Outfitters, Movie Theater
South Square Mall	From the stop at Fayetteville St, take the DATA 5 to Durham Station, then take the DATA 10 to South Square	CVS, Food Lion, Harris Teeter, Movie Theater, Sam's Club, Target
North Pointe Shopping Center	The NCCU Connection is a free connection between Duke and NCCU. Just board the DATA Route 5 Bus and show your student ID. From there, take the Bull City Connector to Duke, or to Golden Belt, including Ninth St and Downtown Durham.
